"We need to get back to our roots — to who we are in Jesus Christ," adds Baxter. "So many men are stuck in a rut, and most of us cannot even tell the extent of our disintegration and attachments to the world. That's the subtlety of the devil. If we do not know that we are not free, we will not seek out the ancient traditions of our Church and the Lord's grace to help us."

Focusing on the three pillars of prayer, asceticism, and fraternity, Exodus 90 provides spiritual formation and growth over a focused period of 90 days with the goal of finishing the 90 days more dependent on God and less attached to worldly distractions and pleasures. This program has been completed by laymen and clergy alike – endorsed by numerous bishops including Most Rev. Kevin C. Rhoades, the group's spiritual advisor.

"Exodus 90 is having a significant impact on men," says Rhoades. "After 90 days, men truly experience a greater freedom – I've seen it with my own eyes."
